### Parliamentary Procedure For Motions

Maintaining order and expediting business at meetings is achieved by the requirement of a motion on actionable topics before discussion is allowed. All members should be familiar with the six steps in handling a main motion 1) a member makes a motion, 2) another member seconds the motion, 3) the presiding officer states the question (repeats the motion), 4) members debate and such debate must be relevant to the pending question, 5) the presiding officer puts the question to a vote, and 6) the presiding officer announces the result. (From NFRW Frequently Asked Questions on Meeting Procedures.)
